



Registration – Why is it important?


- □ All Companies / organisations that wish to participate in the Contracts for Difference will need to register with the Delivery Body.
- □ Necessary to ensure a publically recognised officer of the company / organisation has approved the registration. Usually a Director / Partner the "Authorised Person".




- □ The Authorised Person can nominate a "Main Admin" to act on their behalf to carry out activities.
- ☐ The Main Admin can also be the same person as the Authorised Person based on structure and governance.

Offshore

 Full copy of Crown Estate Lease/Agreement for Lease

Offshore Phased

- Phase 1 MW >= 25% of total MW of all phases
- <=1500MW across all phases
- Target Commissioning Date for last phase <=2 years from 1st Phase

Excluded Applicants



CCS and Nuclear

AD, Hydro, Onshore Wind, Solar =< 5MW

Non GB

Not to be in receipt of another subsidy (RO, CfD, CM, NFFO, RHI if EfW with CHP) except:

RO accredited registering additional capacity >=5MW

RO accredited registering subsequent offshore phases

Biomass co-firer station can switch generating unit(s) from RO to CfD as Biomass Conversions

Excluded Applicants

Subsidy Cross Check

Provide statements that not in NFFO, CfD, RHI (if EfW with CHP), CM; and

Provide statement whether accredited (in RO) – if accredited, provide type of Dual Scheme Plant






Applicable Planning Consents – DB Checks

Parameter	Evidence Requirements
Postcode / OS Map Reference / Grid Coordinates	Information in Application consistent with that specified in Applicable Planning Consent(s)
Capacity	>= capacity requested in Application
Validity Date	Not expired at date of Application
Technology	Technology matches

Some common Qualification Questions

Can I still apply for the RO even if I have applied for a CfD?

My distribution offer has not been countersigned by the DNO – what evidence do I need to provide here?

What considerations do I need to make when determining what my "Initial Installed Capacity Estimate" is?

My planning decision notice does not include a MW Limit? Do I need to provide additional clarification?

My planning permission/connection agreement is in the name of another entity – what evidence do I need to provide?



Application creation and submission

System available



Applicant can create, save, upload documents, print, view

Application Window



Applicant can create, save, upload documents, print, view, submit and withdraw


Application Window Closed

Once closed, Applicant can print and view only

Only Applications that are submitted by Application Window closing date will progress to assessment stage



Reviews

Reviews

- Where Delivery Body ("DB") determine that you are a non qualifying applicant:
 - Applicant can raise non-qualification review via system within defined window
 - Applicant can provide clarification but no new evidence
 - Result communicated via system

Appeals

Appeals

- Where Delivery Body ("DB") determine that you are a non qualifying applicant after Reviews process:
 - Applicant can raise Appeal to Ofgem (cc DB)
 - Results communicated by Ofgem to Applicant and DB
 - Allocation may proceed if overrunning
 - Applicant can appeal to High Court where Ofgem uphold DB decision

Delivery Body required to establish and maintain an **Appeals Register**






