

### APPEALS REGISTER

National Grid is the Delivery Body for Electricity Market Reform (EMR). Part of this role includes the qualification of applicants and the allocation of Contracts for Difference (CFD) in accordance with the CFD legislative framework.

Under Regulation 48 of the Contracts for Difference (Allocation) Regulations (the Regulations), the Delivery Body is required to establish and maintain a register of qualification appeals made to the Authority (“Ofgem”) under Regulation 43 and to publish this once CfD Notifications and/or notices that an applicant has been unsuccessful in an allocation process have been issued.

The following table sets out those qualification appeals that were made during Allocation Round 1, the date of determination of these and the determination of Ofgem. In the event that there are qualification appeals in subsequent Allocation Rounds, the details of these will be added to this table.

In accordance with Allocation Regulation 48(3), the details of any qualification appeal will be removed from the Appeals Register 12 months after the Date of Determination by the Authority.
