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# **1. Agreement management overview**



#### Summary

Agreement management is the administration of milestone obligations that a Capacity Provider must complete once they have been awarded a Capacity Agreement Notice (CAN) following a Capacity Auction. Milestone activities vary depending on the type of CMU and the duration of the Capacity Agreement awarded, certain obligations such as the completion of a Metering Assessment and Satisfactory Performance Days are common to all types of CMU. Certain milestone obligations can be deferred from Prequalification and in most cases must be completed either before the commencement of a Delivery Year or within the year itself (i.e. Satisfactory Performance Days).

This document outlines the current requirements and obligations for Capacity Providers over the coming months up until the start of the next Delivery Year (1 October 2019). For a more detailed overview of all Capacity Market deadlines for all Auctions, click <u>here</u>.

#### **Capacity Market standstill**

The Delivery Body shall continue to support Capacity Providers with meeting their current obligations during the standstill period. However, capacity payments shall not be issued until State Aid approval for the CM has been granted.


